For taste, odor, hardness, sediment, staining, drinking water concerns, well water, and filtration planning.

Clarify the concern

<input type="checkbox"/>	Taste or odor.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hard water or scale.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Sediment or cloudy water.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Staining.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Drinking water concern.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Private well water concern.

Location pattern

<input type="checkbox"/>	Every faucet or one fixture?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Hot water only or cold water too?
<input type="checkbox"/>	Morning only or all day?
<input type="checkbox"/>	After the home sat vacant?
<input type="checkbox"/>	After storms, maintenance, or plumbing work?

Useful details

<input type="checkbox"/>	Municipal water or private well.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Existing filter, softener, RO, or treatment equipment.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Last filter change or service date.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Photos of staining, sediment, filters, or test reports.

Before buying equipment

<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask what the test is designed to answer.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask whether the result points to drinking water, whole-home water, or well water treatment.
<input type="checkbox"/>	Ask what the recommended equipment does not solve.
